The three most invasive rat species, black or ship rat *Rattus rattus*, brown or Norway rats, *R. norvegicus* and Pacific rat, *R. exulans* have been incrementally introduced to islands as humans have explored the world's oceans. They have caused serious deleterious effects through predation and competition, and extinction of many species on tropical islands, many of which are biodiversity hotspots.
